The Mini-Con is a family-friendly event that is welcoming to all of the various populations that call Marshall County home. For this reason, all participants are expected to abide by the following guidelines:

- Costumes should be appropriate for a library setting. All persons must wear a top and shoes. No costume should be excessively revealing, gory, or scary. Any costume that poses a hazard to the safety of the person wearing the costume or others is not permitted.
- All prop weapons must be clearly distinguished from real weapons and handled with care. Anyone using a prop weapon in an aggressive way will be removed from the con.
- Be respectful of others. Ask permission before taking a photo or interacting with another person's costume. Harassment in any form will result in being removed from the con.
- All persons must still abide by the library's code of conduct, which includes but is not limited to:
  - Selling and/or soliciting for services, money, or items is prohibited except for approved vendors.
  - Possessing, consuming, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time is prohibited.
  - Smoking or other uses of any type of tobacco, e-cigarette, or other vaping device is prohibited.
  - Bringing animals other than certified support animals into the library is prohibited.
  - Any behavior or noise created by persons, electronic devices, or cell phones that is disruptive to others is prohibited.
  - No one shall engage in disorderly conduct, fighting, or challenging another to fight, or to use obscene/offensive words or gestures.
- It is the right of library staff to ask any person who is not in compliance with library policy to leave the library. Those who do not comply will be reported for trespassing. Severe infractions may result in being banned from the library.
